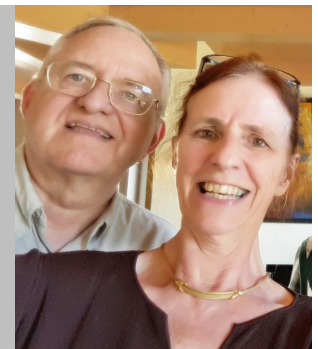

## God Rolled Away the Stone For Those Below



This pic is part of a moment in the history of Islam breaking toward Jesus. Four Imams, Muslim leaders, all converted to Christ and are singing together in Arabic. These Imams have been vicious for 20 years, killing Christians, burning churches, and torturing God's people. The man from Sudan's grand father was one of the founders of the harsh jihadist movement that we see around the world. All four are now lecturers in Europe, highly, highly intelligent, and hunted down for their call of Muslims to Christ.

It was last weekend when Evey and I went to Lyon for a conference and heard these former Imams speak in levels about Christ where we have hardly scratched the surface. One Imam is from Sudan, one from Irak, one from Iran (a Chiite Muslim), and the fourth is from Morocco. One Imam (commander/teacher in the mosque) has been to Mecca, now called a Hajj, fully 14 times. Two of these men lecture as professors in Stuttgart and one is counsel to Angela Merkel in Germany. Faith is not just for small things, but for earth changers too.

After returning to our home about 1 1/2 hours away, we found that someone stole our wonderful 1996 Honda Accord. We got a police report and expected nothing. But I prayed out of knowing God. In 24 hours the police said they "flashed" the car and arrested the thief, 6 hours from here, near Paris. He/she threw away the 3 grandie seats in the back, but we got the car back to the surprise of everyone in the neighborhood. The car wasn't locked. I vacuumed it, cleaned it, washed it and prayed against evil in that car. Runs great.

In September and part of October, Don will speak and hold seminars in 6 churches, mostly in the midwest. He will continue to serve as an inspirer, mentor, motivator, and maximizer for God's glory among all nations... as well as teach and equip at strategic locations. Some meetings will be preaching and Bible study, others will include a 2 or 3 day long seminar to rouse the people of God to seize their crown of gifting and to move out to community or worldwide.

Back at the ranch, our 8 grandkids are learning to swim and ride bikes with pedals. They play "French Bakery," where you have to say Bonjour Madame and Merci Madame, if you want any service or reputation at all.

## The Robe

Few Christians know the meaning of the blind man's healing in Jericho, a city that was destroyed and considered filthy even odorous to Arabs.

But Jesus went to Bartimaeus, the blind beggar and asked him what he needed. We needed a stolen car retrieved.

But why did he stand up and take off his robe or duvet? The secret is that following Jesus requires us to dispose of any and all impediments to following Him. Strip it off.

Not cognitive agreement and thanksgiving to Jesus, but high level followers who tear off old hindrances, habits, (coats and blankets here), e. g. partnerships with the devil, dark dealings and to try a 50-50 life with the Savior. That is a Jesus Christian. Tear off the old, or you can't walk straight to follow Him.

Mark 10.

Nagaland, the high point of India where thousands of Muslims are coming to and living in Christ while still in their Muslim cultural backgrounds.

It is called a Jamaat, like a large ring of house churches where you don't have to be Western to be a Christian. Thus there is little rejection by community Muslims, but growth in the cross of Christ and the transformation of salvation. We have not yet seen the ways God is able to keep a culture from being overlooked and people rescued from rejection.
