God's People Are Moving Forward In Faith

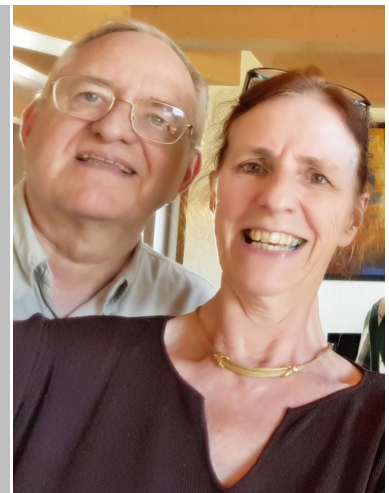
Greetings to prayer and support people of God's mission in our part of the world.

Our present, pressing topic is helping those who live among the “Muslim Urban Poor.” (Did you know that churches have sprung up in these 100,000 plus tent cities in Jordan, Turkey and Lebanon?) This is calling for a higher ministry to Muslims.

I am a screener and recruiter of new, fully committed missionary candidates. I recruited a family from Vegas who live among the urban poor in India—they are now known in many circles of pastoral gatherings, having founded a church along with strong persecution. They teach across India.

I travel a lot. Right now I’m in Yellow Springs, OH and speaking on building up missions teams in 6 churches across the US. One church based team is so strong in the Lord that they literally teach and train major teams like Frontiers on the field. One church out of Texas has built this church-based team that has the power, the sacrifice and the insight to teach many denominational teams which don’t always know the next steps forward. Imagine that one church has so marked this North African part of the world that they are like reading the Book of Acts all over again.

In our home we host major leaders to help them recover from burnout, offenses, weakening vision, and prayer for new direction. Couples have come from German, French, Moroccan and American backgrounds. Those needing further counseling are encouraged to go to a center called in English, the bee hive, or Le Rucher. That is nearby us as well.

Evey knows better than I do that Muslim women are in need of becoming more than 2nd class citizens, some beaten, many treated badly in the home.

Samuel Zwemer said, “As a babe she is unwelcomed; as a child untaught, as a wife unloved, as a mother unhonored, in old age, uncared for, and when her dark and dreary life is ended, she is unmourned by those she has served.”

There are wonderful exceptions, but devotion to the husband and to Islam can be hard. Please pray and give these women reason to rejoice in the God of their salvation.
