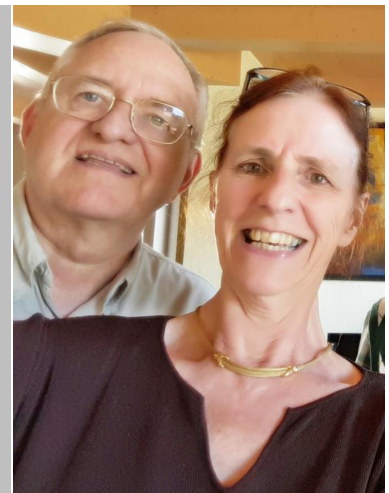

Instead of missionaries from these countries sharing for an hour or two each, this year it was totally the converted Muslims from the above countries who shared. The perspective was totally different. We always had worship in Arabic, Berber, and French — sometimes in English.

Just like letting a Muslim convert speak instead of speaking for him in your home country gives double the impact and opens doors that are otherwise closed, so you want an example of this new manner of letting Muslim converts speak.

About 20 Algerians from various people groups, all converted to Jesus, shared that 2018 was the most persecuted year they ever had in Algeria, churches closed, Christians rounded up, beatings, etc. This resulted now, already this year in more powerful Christians in Algeria, more boldness, more mission work, and a growth of the move of God in Algeria not to 125,000 Christians, but actually twice that number.

Here comes the bomb shell, excuse the analogy: The 20 Algerians from across that Muslim country said they no longer want or need western missionaries in Algeria. Boom! I've been with mission groups that have pounded their heads to get long term visas just to enter Algeria—and the need for that is a phantom.

Another example is that in Mauritania, the country north of Senegal, now has the freedom for converted Muslims to speak openly of Jesus. Part of this is due to an empowerment by the Spirit of God.

I got back from Spanish Melilla, the enclave in Northern Morocco, where my view of the bankrupt nature of Muslim is known by many. Soon I'll leave for Malaga, Spain, to consult with some of the best Muslim teachers in Europe. Another big change noted in Malta was the strong need and yea success of reaching Muslim refugees in EUROPE, a new wave that we are graced to be part of right now in France and in Europe.

Whew! Lots of news. Much more. You have made the difference in your supportive prayers and financial giving and trust in partnership.
