News from the Heckmans, March 15, 2017

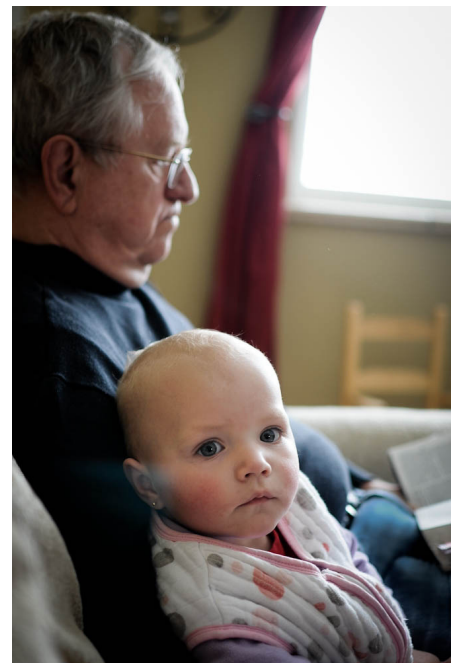
We have 7½ grandkids, with the 8th being born in Denver of Stephen and Kelly fame in May of this year. Just returned from India, just below Bhutan, in a narrow isthmus called Nagaland, where I helped train new pastors to Muslims, mostly around 24 years old. Teaching in the morning and going out 2x2 in the afternoon.

One Muslim woman wanted nothing to do with Christ. But since she was almost blind, the 2 prayed for her and she was totally healed and sighted. So the woman said, Yes, I want to be a Christian and teach me everything I can know to be a Christian.

She is now in a Jamaat, or house group church that grows to 20 and then multiplies. Each Jamaat preserves the culture of the ummah or Muslim cultural fellowship but is strictly Christ centered. Today I witnessed in the market in France to Tashick, a young Algerian man, and asked him, Why do you seek the living (the living Word of God) among the dead (Mohammed)?

Seek the Living Word at night through visions and during the day by asking for communications from Kalimat d'Allah, Jesus the Word. In Malta, we learned about an Imam in a closed country that went to a believer's house and repented, ashen, turned white, frightened, because he met Jesus. Note Grandpa Don with grandson Kai.
