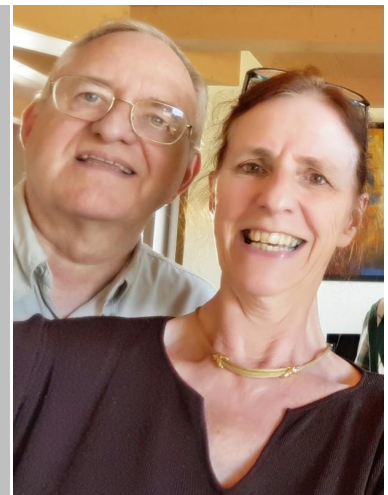

Our endeavors to encourage people and teams and missionaries and Muslim converts is in full swing. Sharing with a top missionary and Bible translator, I was asked if a certain well known TV personality was genuine or not. This is not your normal TV producer, but one who beams TV programs uniquely into Algeria and Morocco, preaching, teaching, distributing Jesus videos, himself an Algerian. If I hesitated on any moral or financial questionability, he would be severely cut off from needed support and millions of Muslims would be affected in North Africa. I know the man well, and gave a glowing report. That's what you do to be an influencer of the Gospel to millions.

More, we are hosting a family that has ministered into the most dangerous Muslim countries in Africa. They are in need and help for a host of reasons. As they come here, I have no magic wand or a quick fix answer for everything. But I do have a deep relationship with them and with the Lord. God will show up and begin to show the way. Understand that these are some of the greatest church planters among Muslims that are active today. Their loss to the field or their uncertainty is a blow to the work of God in the Muslim world. We are privileged to host and listen and care.

We are in talks with other missions to rejuvenate and help encourage many of their workers to find freedom and healing and persistence on the field. You think temptations and conflicts are severe at home. Yes, that's true. But try resolving conflicts and temptations and hurts in dusty, poor countries who do not exactly receive these missionaries with golden robes. We can help and are encouraging and giving the equivalent to a tune-up to a car that sets teams and individuals back to a fired up life.

Mature and seasoned missionaries can sustain other missionaries and open up large vistas of ministries that can only multiply missions for God's glory. We do not live in a mud hut, but our reach is very broad, thanks again to your trust, support and knowledge that God's people, in unity, can leverage ministry from Egypt to Morocco to Spain to France and workers from North Africa this year alone. You too can encourage young missionaries to lift their eyes to the hills and receive their calling and strength from the Lord.
